



Women's Health Case Study

Metastatic Breast Cancer



CSSi was presented with a very challenging Global Metastatic Breast Cancer trial, spanning 16 countries, with narrow enrollment criteria. The anticipated rate of enrollment was 3 patients per site, over a 12 month period.

CSSi supported 10 countries: Colombia, Czech Republic, France, Germany, Italy, Portugal, Peru, Spain, Sweden, and the United States.



Challenge

The sites were not engaged or invested in locating patients for this trial due to the extremely difficult enrollment criteria.

Solution

CSSi created & implemented a clear process for each site to track and identify potential patients before they passed through the narrow window of eligibility. The site efforts were reported at regular intervals.

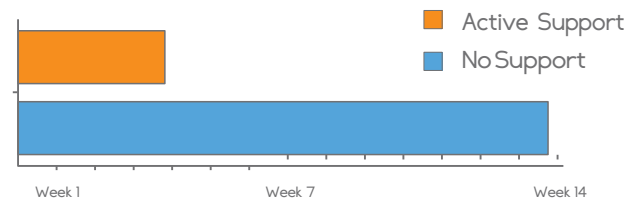
In collaboration with sites, Local Enrollment Specialists:

- Encouraged the use of recruitment tools
- Assisted in pre-screening activities
- Provided support and processes to initiate discussions with referring physicians and colleagues
- Implemented a long-term plan for identifying future patients from both internal and external sources

Results

CSSi supported sites screened their first patient over 3x faster than unsupported sites.

Average Weeks From Activation to First Screen



The impact of CSSi's support decreased the enrollment period from the projected 12 months to 9 months, **25% faster** than originally planned.
